Save your answers in one file, in .pdf format, use your name as the file name, and remember to attach them to the email when submitting your completed application. Your response to each topic should be a minimum of eight to ten sentences and a maximum of one page in length. Answer all! Remember – there are no “right” or “wrong” responses.

- Give an overview of your personal history, including
 - a. where you grew up,
 - b. your relationship with your mother,
 - c. your relationship with your father,
 - d. your relationship with your sibling(s),
 - e. family situations (childhood to present), and
 - f. how you feel these experiences will affect your involvement with GBBC.

- Tell us about your spiritual life, including
 - a. how and when you became a Christian,
 - b. your personal growth in Christ,
 - c. describe your current walk with the Lord, including how your faith is growing,
 - d. the spiritual influences in your life,
 - e. your quiet times,
 - f. church involvement,
 - g. outreach activities in which you have been involved, and
 - h. how much of the Bible you have read in the past year.

- Who, in addition to the Lord, has made the biggest impact on your life? Please explain.

- List and explain
 - a. what you perceive to be your greatest strengths, and
 - b. what you perceive to be your greatest weaknesses.

- Talk about why you are applying
 - a. Explain how and why God is calling you to become a student at Green Bay Bible College.
 - b. Explain
 - i. what your goals and expectations are, and
 - ii. what you hope to see accomplished in your life through this education process.
 - c. Include how you believe GBBC can help you
 - i. reach your goals,
 - ii. meet your expectations,
 - iii. prepare you for a career or leadership position in ministry.
